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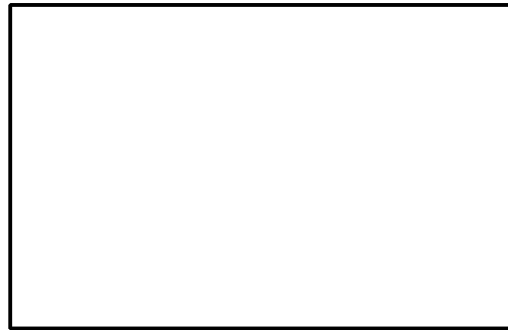

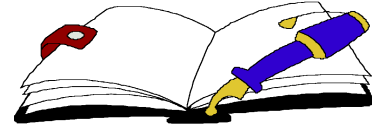

- an unfortunate things that happened to them

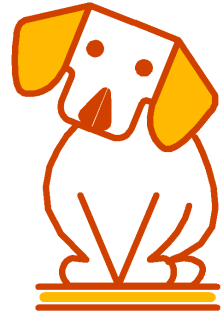
Concluding Paragraph (3 -5 sentences)
